Shari'ah / legal information for Testator/ Testatrix

- 1] You must be mentally capable of understanding the nature and consequences of your Will.
- 2] You must be 16 years of age or older.
- 3] Witnesses must be aged 14 years or older and competent to give evidence in a court of law.
- 4] Sign each page of the will [preferably in black pen], yourself and together with two competent witnesses present at the same time and in each others' presence.
- 5] The following persons may not sign as witnesses: heirs, those named as beneficiaries, guardians, executors or trustees [and their spouses]
- 6] Any additions, deletions and changes to the Will must be legible and individually signed by the Testator and each witness in the margin opposite the changes. Please avoid additions, deletions and alterations as these could cause problems later. It is preferable to make a new Will if you desire any change.
- 7] It is recommended that your Will be executed under the supervision of a person nominated by the Jamiatul Ulama or other competent Darul Ifta. You may otherwise not word provisions correctly which could invalidate your Will.
- 8] If you are signing with a cross or thumbprint, please do so in the presence of a commissioner of oaths.
- 9] Testator means a man who makes a Will. Testatrix means a woman who makes a Will.
- 10] Assumption means discretion given to the executor/executrix.

Advice to the Testator

- 1] Take time to ensure meticulous completion of your will.
- 2] The copy of your Will should be kept with other important documents. Inform one or more responsible members of your family of its location. Without placing unnecessary burden on anyone, you may also inform them of any specific wish in relation to your Janazah. Noting this in the Will itself may often be too late as most Islamic Wills are read only after the funeral rites have been completed.
- 3] The booklet accompanying your Will "Guide to the Executor/ Executrix" must be updated regularly.

 Please try to keep clear records of what you own, what is owed to you and what you owe. It should not be that due to negligence or laziness we are made to repay someone in the Hereafter with the currency of the Aakhira [our few precious good deeds]
- 4] If you are married in any way other than "Ante nuptial without accrual", the marriage contract may be contrary to the Shari'ah. Please seek appropriate advice in this regard and if necessary, have the contract legally altered so that it conforms to the Shari'ah.

Advice to the Heirs

- 1 Contact the family doctor or local hospital for a death certificate. Contact the local burial service for funeral arrangements. Request a calm friend or family member to assist in this regard.
- 21 Ensure family members conduct themselves in a dignified manner in keeping with Islamic principles.
- 31 Heirs [either collectively or individually as the case may be] are responsible for payment of recurring accounts e.g. electricity & telephone to ensure continued services.
- 4] Do not take any action regarding any asset before proper consultation with the executor/executrix.
- 5] Inform the employer and pension fund as soon as possible for early processing of benefits.
- 6] The estate is to be wound up as expeditiously as possible.
- 8] Do not decide collectively to donate from the estate. It may be that one of the Heirs may not be in a position to do so, but out of embarrassment will agree.

Waasiyat of the Mayyit

- 1. Please give me a quick but proper ghusal immediately so that Ibadat can commence.
- Put me in a room without pictures and facing the Qibla. Do not allow any ghair mahram to see my face and do not allow any lady with hair showing to sit in the room.
- Do not cry loudly.
- Do not allow any ghair mahram to carry my Janazah out of the house or inside the grave. Please do not delay my Janazah.
- Do not make any performance for me a compulsory occasion. Read on behalf of all marhooms from anywhere at all times.
- Do not gather at my house especially on Thursday and have parties. Do not force
 yourselves to bring cakes and savouries and then judge whose are nice. I won't be there
 to give any comments.
- 7. If you read the Quran or any particular Surah from the Quran, please ensure you have proper Wudhu and conform with its adhab eg. those relating to the hijab of your body and voice. Do not feel obliged to read long Surahs. I will greatly appreciate it if you read one Kalimah or Durood or perform one good action with sincerity on my behalf. InshaAllah it may serve as a mercy for both of us.
- 8. If you read Surah Ikhlaas only three times, I will get the Sawaab of reading one Quran.
- Please do not beautify my grave with flowers. Instead give the money to the poor and beautify the grave with your presence and duas.
- 10. If I have offended you in any way now or when alive, Please forgive me.

My Dear Child - some useful advices

Bismillahir Rahmaanir Raheem

My dear child, [or other relevant person]

You will be reading this after my death. Please read the following as though I am addressing you from my Qabr. I may now be lying underground within a space of approximately two metres by one metre. All around me is sand except for the pieces of wood above supporting the load of sand. That too is weakening and the entire load of sand may soon fall directly on me.

Be assured that I loved you. My heart and soul was concentrated on you from the time Allah Subhanahu Wata aala granted you to me. Your beautiful and innocent smile reminded me of Allah Subhanahu Wata aala's beauty. Your cry caused me immense pain and I went out of my way to comfort you. As you grew and attended Madrassah to learn the name of Allah Subhanahu Wata' Aala, the Quran and how to perform Salah, you represented an investment to me far greater than any worldly investment I may have left behind. You would make duas and seek forgiveness on my behalf when I would be unable to do so.

My dear child, that day has come. You are on the face of the Earth and I may be lying paralysed in its belly. How true is the Hadith of Rasulullah Sallallahu Alaihi Wassallam that a person in the grave is like a drowning person. He awaits the rewards from his beloved. Dear child, I cannot utter a single Subhanallah. You are my flesh and blood. Hove you and if you really love me, I implore you to:

 Be obedient to Allah Subhanahu Wata Aala, That is the greatest reward for you. I am informed of whatever you do; your good deeds please me and your bad deeds cause me pain.

Dear child, I know the pain of my death and my absence will gradually decrease and you will carry
on with your life. Don't let the engagement of the world make you oblivious of death. Think of me
regularly and know that your day will come soon. To remember death and to prepare for it, send
Yaseen every day for me. I will look forward to receiving it.

3. If you can, give some Sadaqa and charity to the poor and needy on my behalf. Allah Subhanahu Wata Aala, gave you, you love me, give on my behalf.

4. I am lonely in the Qabr. Come and visit me and make Salaam to me. You may not see me or hear me, but InshaAllah I may see you and hear you. Your standing beside me and making Dua at my Qabr will invoke Allah Subhanahu Wata Aala's mercy on both of us.

 Remember, we are from Allah Subhanahu Wata' Aala, and to Allah Subhanahu Wata' Aala, is our return. We are merely travellers for a brief moment, but our actions here will determine our future for ever.

Dear child, exercise patience. We will meet in the Aakhira Insha Allah. For that, guard yourself against Shaitan and his tricks.







I hereby direct that a Certificate issued by the Jamiatul-Ulama Natal or other competent Darul Ifta shall be binding and conclusive as to the aforesaid Islamic Law and the distribution of my Estate.

I direct that any share under this Will which devolves upon a female, be paid to and become her sole, absolute and exclusive property and be excluded from the community of property that may now or hereafter exist between her and any husband she has married or may marry. I also direct that any share under this Will which devolves upon a male, be paid to and become his sole, absolute and exclusive property and be excluded from the community of property that may now or hereafter exist between him and any wife he has married or may marry.




I hereby direct that any inheritance accruing to a minor child in terms hereof shall not be paid into the Guardians fund but shall be held in Trust by my said Executor/s, Administrator/s until the said minor attains the age of majority in which event my said Administrator/s shall pay over to the said minor child his/her share of inheritance. The age of majority mentioned above shall be determined by Islamic Law. My said Executor/s Administrator/s shall be empowered to invest assets held in Trust in such investments that are in accordance with Islamic Law. My Executor/s / Administrator/s are authorized in their discretion to apply the income and in case of need, a portion of the Capital of the Trust assets for the maintenance, education and general welfare of the beneficiary of the Trust provided that any such application of income is in accordance with the Islamic Law. Consequently, my Executor/s / Administrator/s are hereby appointed as Trustee/s of such Trust as will come into existence.

Should any Wasiyyat (Bequest) of mine as described in 7.2.1 to 7.2.8 above be in conflict with Islamic Law, then the Jamiatul Ulama Natal or other competent Darul Ifta shall have the power to adjust/modify such bequest in order that it complies with Islamic Law, as the purpose of this will is to ensure compliance with my Islamic obligations relating to the devolution of my estate.

Introduction

Hadrath Abdullah Ibn Umar Radiallahu Anhu narrates that RasulAllah Sallallahu Alayhi Wassallam is reported to have said: "It is not permissible for any Muslim who has anything to will, that he may pass even two nights without having his last Will & Testament written & kept ready with him." [Mishkat]

The objectives of a will are:

- 1] To comply with Allah Subhanahu Wata Ala's commands
- 2] To concientise oneself of ones obligations
- 3] To detail ones assets & liabilities
- 4] To bequeath one third of the estate

The testator has no say with regards to the portion of the estate devolving on legitimate heirs which must be distributed in accordance with Shari'ah.

ANY WILL CONTRARY TO THE SHAR'IAH IS HARAAM & INVOKES THE WRATH OF ALLAH Subhanahu Wata' Ala.

THE PROPORTIONS:

The determination of the legal heirs & their proportionate shares is fixed in the Qur'an & thus minimizes conflicts.

Allah Subahanu Wata 'Ala says in the holy Quran "From what is left by parents & those nearest related - there is a share for men & a share for women - whether the property be large or small. A share made Fardh [compulsory]." S4.V7

Shari'ah / Legal CAPACITY TO MAKE A WILL

The testator must be :-

1] 16 years of age or older.

2] of sound mind & memory

3] fully aware of the consequences of the Will

4] acting voluntarily

The following may not benefit from a Will

- A murder or accessory to the murder of the testator/testatrix.
- A person who has unduly influenced the testator/ testatrix to benefit from the Will.
- A person who witnesses the will or a person who was his/her spouse at the time of attestation.

Note

- A foetus is recognized by Shari ah as an heir if born alive within the Islamically acceptable period of pregnancy.
- Non Muslim relatives may not inherit from a Muslim.
 However non Muslims or organizations may benefit from bequests.
- A person who writes or drafts the Will on behalf of the testator/testatrix may not benefit from such a will except as a compulsory heir. Such a person may also not be appointed as an executor.

GUIDE TO CONTENTS OF THE WILL

Please note that the only acceptable marriage contract in Islam is "out of community of property without accrual" If one is married in any other system, please discuss this with an Aalim and if necessary take corrective action. The Umhlanga Islamic Society [fax 031 562 8861] or brother Mohammed [083 99 33 902] may be contacted for a list of attorneys who could assist for a nominal fee if a legal application to the High Court is required.

- Select an executor/ executrix who is conscious of Allah as well as has the time & skills to act on your behalf.
- 7.2 This booklet serves as a guide to your executors regarding your unfulfilled obligations. Please be meticulous in its completion and update details regularly. Remember that you are required to fulfill your obligations to the best of your ability during your lifetime and every attempt should be made to do so. Unusual circumstances may result in some act remaining unaccomplished and this clause then attempts to compensate for this.
- 7.2.8 This clause allows for the Testator to bequeath a portion of the estate to persons or organizations who are not heirs. The total of such bequests may not exceed one third of the estate nor may it include any compulsory heir.
- 10. The Guardians Fund receives & administers inheritances due to minors. These funds are deposited in interest bearing accounts making the income Haraam. Executors need to ensure that funds are invested in Shari'ah compliant avenues.

UNPERFORMED SALAAH

Only Fardh [or in the case of Hanafi, Fardh & Wajib] Salaah need to be compensated for.

An estimation needs to be made from the time of attaining maturity [Baaligh] and every attempt needs to be made to redeem these. Record hereunder the approximate number missed and update regularly as they are performed.

The current amount needs to be verified with the Jamiat or other competent Darul Ifta.

Note that the amount paid may not exceed one third of the estate after payment of funeral expenses and debts & will therefore go unpaid unless paid personally by a well-wisher

Please update as Qaza Umri is performed

UNPAID ZAKAAH

Muslims are liable for Zakaah once he or she owns the Nisaab [Minimum zakaatable wealth]

A calculation of unpaid Zakaah needs to be made, recorded and paid at the earliest possibility. If any amount remains unpaid, the executor must pay this from the one third of the estate after payment of funeral expenses and debts.

UNPERFORMED HAJJ

Hajj is obligatory on every sane Muslim once all requisites are present.

If one has not performed the Hajj despite it being obligatory, one must repent and perform same at the first available opportunity.

Due to old age or sickness, with no hope of regaining health, a proxy may be arranged to perform this obligation. The proxy should preferably be from ones neighbourhood, but if funds do not permit, the proxy may be appointed from Saudi Arabia.

For the benefit of the executor/executrix, please note below whether the Hajj has become compulsory & if accomplished.

UNKEPT FAST [SAUM]

A calculation needs to be made of all outstanding fasts including those missed due to legitimate reasons at the time e.g. due to illness, travel, menstruation or childbirth. These must then be redeemed at the earliest opportunity. If however, one is still unable to fulfill this obligation due to frailty or protracted illness and there is no hope of regaining health, Fidyah needs to be paid. Information on these payments needs to be made available to the executor.

KAFFARAH FOR UNFULFILLED OATHS

Kaffarah [penalty] must be paid for breaking an oath.

An oath [Yamin] is where a permissible act is made compulsory e.g. a student promises to perform a certain number of Nafl Salaah on passing an exam; or a person takes an oath to abstain from a Halaal food.

The penalty for breaking an oath is to feed or clothe 10 poor people or if unable, to fast for 3 days.
