Respected Muftis, Respected Ulama, Honourable Guests, and all those that are listening to this program:

All praise is due to Allah alone, Who has granted us the Tawfeeq to engage in the field of learning and imparting the knowledge of Deen.

The engagement of learning and imparting the knowledge of Deen is a very great bounty of Allah. Almighty Allah chooses whoever He wants to bear this sacred knowledge and impart this sacred knowledge.

Hadhrat Ali Radhyallahu Anhu has encapsulated the essence of the knowledge of Deen in the following few couplets:

We are happy with the decree of Jabbar (Allah), regarding us.

For us is the knowledge of Deen, and for the unlearned, is wealth.

Verily, wealth will soon decrease,

and knowledge will remain forever.

During the battle of Hunain, when Rasulullah (Sallallahu Alayhi Wasallam) was distributing wealth to some people who newly accepted Islam, some people felt that they should be more deserving of the booty. Rasulullah (Sallallahu Alayhi Wasallam) gathered the Ansaar in a tent and told them,

Are you'll not happy that people are taking wealth (sheep and camels) to their homes, and the Rasul of Allah is returning to Madinah with you? (Sahih Al-Bukhari- 4330)

The Ansaars returned home, to Madinah Munawwarah with the physical presence of Rasulullah (Sallallahu Alayhi Wasallam). Similarly, a student of Deen returns home with the spiritual presence of Rasulullah (Sallallahu Alayhi Wasallam) in the form of the knowledge of Deen.

I always advise students that a businessman conducts an audit at the end of his business term. When he observes that his wealth has increased, he becomes proud and happy with the increase of wealth.

When a student of Deen conducts an audit upon the official completion of his studies, he returns home with something more superior than the wealth of a businessman. A student of Deen actually returns home with the inheritance of Rasulullah (Sallallahu Alayhi Wasallam).

The Darul Iftaa has been extremely busy with Covid-19 related questions ranging from,

- 1. Contagious diseases
- 2. Wearing the face masks

- 5. Disputes between landlords and tenants

- 7. Disputes between travel agents and clients due to Haj and Umrah bookings and cancellations.

Our approach in addressing such issues is the following Hadith:

Translation: Just people will carry this knowledge of Deen from the pious ancestors,

- 1) They will reject the changes made by extremists.
- 2) They reject wrong attributions of false claims.
- 3) They will reject incorrect interpretations of ignorant people.

We have observed from the rulings of the Illustrious Fuqahaa and our Akabir Muftis that whilst they adopted Taqwa in their personal lives, they adopted a moderate and practical approach in guiding the Ummah.

We advise one and all to tolerate differences of opinion and not let the differences pollute and contaminate our Imaan and spirituality.

Whilst there was much discussion on the vaccine issue against the virus, there should now be more discussion on vaccinating ourselves against extremism, against intolerance, and against engaging in backbiting, gossiping, and referring to Ulama and Muftis with derogative names and terms.

Remember, the Deen of the general masses lie in respecting the Ulama. If the masses lose and respect for the Muftis and Ulama, that will corrode their Iman. It is also the responsibility of the Ulama themselves to display and promote mutual respect for Ulama.

When we differ with each other, it should be done with decorum and honour and without compromising in presenting what we believe to be the correct view.

The AskImam website run by the Darul Iftaa is now revamped and launched with new facilities.

The IdealWoman website is also run by the Darul Iftaa and has been very useful in guiding women in feminine related issues.

The Darul Mahmood website is an Islahi website. All the Islahi talks are uploaded on that website. The Duroos of Bukhari Shareef and the discourses on Al Heelatun Naajizah are also on the Darul Mahmood website.

One Humanity

The Darul Iftaa operates the One Humanity welfare Foundation.

I personally oversee the running of One Humanity activities.

One Humanity has been very active during Covid-19 in various places in South Africa, Jordan, Syria, Gaza, and Malawi.

Mediation and Arbitration

Alhamdulillah, the Darul Iftaa also provides the services of commercial mediation and arbitration. In the past two years, we have successfully mediated and arbitrated many commercial related disputes worth many millions of Rands. Most of our interventions are resolved through mediation. This is well known in the business sector.

We humble advise our business community to resolve their business disputes according to Shariah and avoid referring the disputes to the courts. This is a wastage of money and resources. Besides that, the ruling of the courts are not according to Shariah.

Investment Schemes and Shariah Compliancy

The Darul Iftaa has designed the Al-Mabroor Buffalo, Al-Mabroor Property, and Al-Mabroor Cattle Investment Schemes to be Shariah compliant. We have been receiving queries about new cattle investment schemes in some places in Natal and other places. The Darul Iftaa have approved only the Al-Mabroor Cattle investment schemes and no other cattle investment schemes. No other cattle investment scheme should be attributed to the Darul Iftaa.

The Darul Iftaa also oversees the Shariah compliancy of HBZ Islamic Branch.

Al-Ansaar Foundation has requested Darul Iftaa to oversee its Zakat activities and have given the Darul Iftaa complete mandate over its Zakat portfolios. Al-Ansaar has many noble welfare projects and the Darul Iftaa is committed to assist Al-Ansaar in their welfare projects through its Zakat portfolio.

The Darul Iftaa has designed Mega Rewards, a Shariah compliant Halal rewards programme which will be launched soon.
